## WHAT ARE THE LAWS?

**✗ 0-18**      **✓ 19+**

Don't sell tobacco to anybody who is or looks like they are under 19.

**✗**  **✓** 

Don't sell single cigarettes.

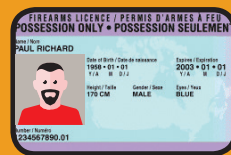
**✗ 0-17**  **✓ 18+**

Don't sell rolling papers to anybody under 18.

## ONLY VALID ID CAN BE USED:



Driver's licence



Firearms licence



Certificate of Canadian citizenship with a photo



Passport



Any form of government ID with photo, birthdate and signature

## MAKING SURE SOMEONE IS **19+**

Ask for photo ID from everybody who looks under 25.



Look for the birthday.



Use the tobacco age checker sticker or download an age calculation app for your phone if you are not sure.



Make sure the photo matches the customer.



Feel the ID and look at it to make sure it is smooth and has no glue lines.



## A FEW THINGS TO REMEMBER

- ➔ You can be fined, punished or fired for selling tobacco to someone younger than 19.
- ➔ Don't let customers touch the tobacco until the sale has been completed.
- ➔ You are allowed to refuse a sale.
- ➔ If you feel unsafe, call the store manager.

## THINGS TO SAY AND DO TO REFUSE A SALE

- Be polite.
- Point to the sign near the till about not selling to minors.

"I'm sorry, it is against the law for me to sell you tobacco."
